Two-Wheel Outreach

VETMotorsports non-clinical outreach places wounded veterans in motorcycle pit crews.

This is family-oriented and held at select venues nation-wide. Events can range from a one-day to three-days. Placement into teams is assessed on a case by case basis by evaluating mechanical abilities and any physical/mental limitations.

Veterans must be able to commit to the entire scheduled event.

VETMotorsports provides the following:

- A crew passes plus access for one caregiver and/or family member,
 - A team jersey, work gloves and hat,
 - A team environment with on-site training, physical and mental engagement and direction,
 - Meals and lodging are provided depending on the event.

Wounded Veteran participants need to provide the following:

- Some mechanical aptitude or background,
- Being at ease with large groups of people.

Four-Wheel Outreach

VETMotorsports is a non-clinical outreach places wounded veterans behind the wheel of cars in a closed course environment. Events are family-oriented as select regional venues and are one-day. Veterans must be able to commit to the entire scheduled event.

VETMotorsports provides the following:

- A car and fuel for our veteran driver,
 - Food and drink,
- The ability for a caregiver and/or family member to ride-along,
 - A team jersey and hat,
- On-site training, physical and mental engagement and direction.

Wounded Veteran participants need to provide the following:

- A valid driver's license,
- Being at ease with large groups of people.
